

HELP PRESERVE PARADISE PRE-HURRICANE PREPARATION GUIDELINES

Dispose of Your Solid Waste Properly

KEEP IT CLEAN & SAFE!

- Clear home(s) and yard(s) of any debris that could become air-borne.
- Remove any loose or low-hanging tree branches.

WHERE DO I TAKE MY WASTE?

- Depending on the type of waste, please follow these guidelines for proper disposal:
 - Regular household waste should be disposed of at a designated bin site.
 - Bulk waste (bedding and furniture), white goods (refrigerators, stoves, washers/dryers) and e-waste (computers and printers) should be taken directly to the convenience centers (please see schedule for more details), transfer stations or landfills.
 - Green waste (yard debris), hazardous waste (oil and grease), construction and demolition debris (wood and concrete), scrap metal, and other similar waste are only accepted at the transfer stations or landfills.
- Residents using the VIWMA facilities are asked to follow the directives of the staff at the site.

WHERE DO BUSINESS OWNERS TAKE THEIR WASTE?

- Depending on the type of waste and quantity of waste, businesses are required to have a permit and/or use a permitted waste hauler and must dispose of their waste at the transfer stations or landfills. Any business found utilizing a public bin site for disposal of commercial waste will be cited.
