Operations and Maintenance Technician II - Operations and Maintenance Technician II is the journey-level class in the Operations and Maintenance Technician series. Employees in this classification perform a full range of skilled maintenance, repair, installation, and operational duties associated with the Authority's wastewater collection system. Assignments require a greater degree of technical knowledge, independent judgment, and responsibility than the Operations and Maintenance Technician I classification. Employees may provide guidance to less experienced personnel and are expected to perform assigned duties with minimal supervision.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Perform a full range of preventative, corrective, and emergency maintenance on the Authority's wastewater collection system, feeder lines, pump stations, and related facilities.
- Perform preventative maintenance and repairs to house pumps, auxiliary pumps, valves, and related equipment to ensure efficient operation.
- Inspect, troubleshoot, repair, and maintain gravity mains, force mains, sewer laterals, lift stations, and associated wastewater infrastructure.
- Operate high-pressure rodding equipment, manual power rodders, pumps, generators, and other specialized equipment used in the maintenance of the wastewater collection system.
- Remove debris, roots, grease, and other obstructions from sewer mains, lift stations, and related structures to maintain proper system flow.
- Install, repair, and maintain sewer lines and related wastewater collection system components.
- Identify and report defects within the wastewater collection system, including cracks, leaks, infiltration, collapsed lines, and other conditions requiring corrective action.
- Perform confined space entry in accordance with Authority policies and established safety procedures, including atmospheric testing and ventilation requirements.

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- Respond to emergency call-outs and serve in an emergency standby capacity, including evenings, weekends, and holidays, as required.
- Maintain accurate maintenance records, work orders, inspection reports, and other documentation related to assigned work activities.
- Perform related duties as assigned.

EDUCATION/SKILLS AND EXPERIENCE:

- High School Diploma or GED from an accredited school.
- Two (2) years of progressively responsible experience in wastewater collection system maintenance, construction, utility maintenance, or a closely related field.
- Possession of, or the ability to obtain within the required timeframe, a Grade I Wastewater Collection System Operator Certification.
- A valid U.S. Virgin Islands Class B Driver's License is required.
- Experience operating power tools, small motorized equipment, and heavy equipment.
- Ability to work in confined spaces, varying weather conditions, and perform physically demanding work.
