O&M Technician II - This is the full journey-level class in the Operations and Maintenance Technician series. Employees in this class are distinguished from the Operations and Maintenance Technician I by the performance of the full range of duties as assigned, including serving as lead worker on small O&M crews as assigned. Employees at this level receive only occasional instruction, or assistance as new or usual situations arise, and are fully aware of the operating procedures and policies of the work unit.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Perform a full range of general and preventative maintenance and cleaning duties to the Authority's waste water collection system, feeder and pump stations.
- Perform preventative maintenance to house and auxiliary pumps to ensure efficient operation.
- Check operations of house pumps and other auxiliary equipment and perform repairs if necessary.
- Cleans and rods sewer mains and laterals.
- Operates high pressure rodders and manual power rodders to remove foreign material or blockage from inside pipes.
- Remove foreign material from lift stations and related structures.
- Repairs gravity mainline and force mains; repairs laterals; remove roots; repairs infiltration sealing and grouting.
- Installs and maintains sewer lines.
- Removes weeds and debris from pump stations, easements, grounds and outfall lines.
- Identifies any signs of blockage that may interrupt flow of the collection system; such as cracks, damage, holes and collapsed collection system.
- Performs work in confined spaces, performs necessary precautions prior to entering confined spaces with potential hazardous atmosphere, use air quality monitor and ventilators.
- Sets traffic control including safety devices, signs and barricades; ensures safety of public and work crews.
- Serves in emergency standby capacity and performs all aspects of collection system maintenance and repair during after hour periods including holidays and weekends.
- Maintains records of maintenance and work performed.
- Perform related duties as required.

EDUCATION/SKILLS AND EXPERIENCE:

- A High School Diploma or GED from an accredited school.
- One (1) to two (2) year of responsible experience performing duties comparable to an Operations and Maintenance Technician I or Comparable experience perfuming wastewater collection system maintenance and repair duties.
- Must have a Grade 1 Wastewater Collections System certificate
- A valid US Virgin Islands driver's license is required.
- Must be experienced in handling power tools, small motorized equipment as well as heavy equipment.
