DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Performs general labor at the Household Hazardous Waste Collection Facility and convenience center, including site set up, clean up, inventory, routine inspection, bulking, unloading and lab packing of hazardous wastes.
- Properly identifies waste for segregation, packing, bulking, and transportation in accordance with applicable federal and local laws and regulations.
- Certifies all materials shipped according to United States Department of Transportation (DOT) requirements.
- Follows standards for operations set by Occupational and Health Administration (OSHA), including wearing protective clothing.
- Prepares and loads shipments of hazardous waste.
- Operates certain equipment, including, but not limited to, trucks, pumps and pressure washers, forklifts, electric forklifts, and pallet jacks.
- Performs hazardous categorization tests to identify unknown materials for proper labeling and disposal.
- Responds to inquires and provides information to the public
- Picks up household hazardous waste from qualified residents, bin sites, convenience centers and roadsides.
- Schedules contractors for disposal of materials,
- Maintains inventory of shipping materials and supplies and orders purchases as needed.
- Perform related duties as assigned.
